A WORD OF THANKS:

On September 21, Sister Catherine Ntoloane wrote to thank all our provinces for their assistance at this time of drought in Lesotho:

"By now we have received an amount of over three hundred and sixty thousand Maloti (about \$34,000 CAD) from our Provinces, various groups and individual persons for the Famine Project. A committee of five sisters here is working on the project, and this week they have been able to supply food (maize meal, soup and cooking oil) to all the institutions where we work – ours and those of the parishes. By next week, we will be supplying other vulnerable groups. We are all very excited."

In the coming week, we will send another \$10,000 for famine relief and for access to potable water in Lesotho.
