Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity, January 18 to 25, 2017:

Reconciliation—the Love of Christ Compels Us (2 Cor. 5): This biblical text emphasizes that reconciliation is a gift from God, intended for the entire creation. "God was reconciling the world (kosmos) to God's self in Christ, not counting people's sins against them and he has committed to us the message of reconciliation" (v. 19).
