HERITAGE EXPLORATION

Guided tour at 10:15 a.m. and at 1:15 p.m.
Preregistration in advance is required

Outdoor tour to discover the property and building heritage

- History of the parish school, now the Foundation House | Introduction to the oldest original house | Congregational House | Traces of the Saint-Antoine Brook... | In case of rain, this tour will take the form of a presentation indoors

BEATIFICATION EXPLORATION

Guided tour at 10:30 a.m. and at 1:30 p.m.
Preregistration in advance is required

Commented presentation on the beatification process

(Length of the presentation: approximately 45 minutes)

- Discover some aspects of the process that led to the beatification of Mother Marie-Rose, along with a mini-exhibition.
- Round out this presentation with a visit to the museum dedicated to her or take in the Educate to Liberate exhibition that commemorates the Congregation's 175 years.

Guided spiritual exploration at 11:30 a.m. and at 2:30 p.m.
Preregistration in advance is required
